

Covid 19 mitigation

The University of Texas at Austin is open for business. We invite you to choose the attendance option, whether virtual or in-person, that best suits your needs and concerns.

In accordance with UT Austin policy, the following procedures will be in effect for those opting to participate in-person:

- Providing proof-of-vaccination will not be required to attend the summit; however, we encourage individuals who can be vaccinated to do so.
- UT Austin and the Texas-EU Business Summit organizing committee **highly encourage** all attendees to wear masks and practicing social distancing – regardless of vaccination status – while inside university buildings.
- Unvaccinated or not-yet-fully vaccinated individuals are highly encouraged to wear a mask at all times on UT Austin campus.
- Masks, while optional, will be made available to all attendees who choose to wear one; hand sanitizing stations will also be available to everyone.
- As required for large, in-person gatherings, a list of in-person attendees and their contact information will be provided to UT Health Austin for potential public health use only. Your personal information will not be shared with anyone outside of UT Health Austin.

If you exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 or feel unwell in any way leading up to or the day of the summit, please attend virtually. The organizing staff can help you change your attendance method. Should you test positive for COVID-19 within 10 days of attending the summit, please report this to the organizers at TXEUSummit@austin.utexas.edu. Your name and personal information will not be shared with anyone outside of UT Health Austin.
